



CYPRIA AUCTIONS - Press Release

The island's first major auction specializing in fine art work will take place at the **Hilton Hotel Nicosia at 6.30 pm Wednesday 13 December 2006**. The viewing is on Monday and Tuesday 9.00 am – 9.00 pm and Wednesday 9.00 am to 1.00 pm at the Hilton Nicosia.

Cypria Auctions is cooperation between K Antiques & Fine Arts Ltd and known auctioneer Petros Vergos. Work including mainly paintings by older Greek and Cypriot artists will be auctioned.

Vergos Auction House was founded in 1989. Since then 12 auctions of 19th and 20th century Greek Paintings have taken place with great success. A further 41 auctions of rare books, documents and prints have successfully taken place.

K Antiques and Fine Arts Ltd was the result of the art-dealing activities of George and Ritsa Kyriacou in the late seventies, with the establishment of showrooms in London and the launching of Gallery K in Athens in 1982. This became the vehicle and outlet of K Antiques and Fine Arts, registered in London the following year. The gallery traded in a wide range of works of paintings, sculptures, antiques and objects d'art. In 1990, the company launched Gallery K in London with the specific purpose of showing and promoting contemporary art, in particular Greek art. Gallery K expanded its activities by launching in November 1999 Gallery K in Nicosia, which has proven to be a resounding success.
